50th ANNUAL CLARKSVILLE CHRISTMAS PARADE RULES

1. Floats must have a minimum of 1,000 lights on them: vehicles must have 250, horses and motorcycles must have 100 each and walkers must have 25. This is the **MINIMUM** requirement to participate; as a rule **MORE IS BETTER!**
2. Vehicles towing floats must be fully decorated.
3. Floats must be built on a trailer no smaller than 4' x 8' and must follow the theme of the parade.
4. Walkers accompanying floats must be kept to a minimum and dressed in holiday attire or a uniform.
5. **ALL** horses must include clean up personnel and **WILL BE LOCATED AT THE END OF THE PARADE. NO EXCEPTIONS**
6. No candy can be thrown from any entry during the parade due to safety issues of doing a night time parade. Please abide this rule. Walkers can hand out candy along the route.
7. The Jaycees will provide the only Santa and Mrs. Claus in the parade.
8. At check in you will be provided a number, please place this number in the front right windshield of the vehicle for proper identification at the grand stand.
9. All floats must carry a fire extinguisher and no open flames will be allowed on floats.

We reserve the right to refuse participation of any entry deemed inappropriate or if the entry does not comply with the minimum light rule.

PARADE DAY INFORMATION

This year's route will begin on 8th Street on the campus of APSU. From 8th Street, floats will proceed to College and then to University and begin following the same route as years past going around public square, then around the County Court House and back to Franklin. From Franklin we will turn onto 8th Street back onto the Campus. When arriving on parade day, we ask that you enter the APSU campus from Kraft or Drane Street.

Registration will be in the Burt Elementary School parking lot at APSU (beside Governors Stadium) from 1:30pm until 3:30pm. **Please be on time as the parade will start at 5pm SHARP!** There will be **NO GAPS** this year so please pay attention and keep up with the parade.

We will require a new toy for all entries. The toy needs to be new, unwrapped and brought to the registration table upon registering your float. All toys will be distributed to the less fortunate children in the Clarksville-Montgomery County area for the Christmas Holiday. Please do not exceed the \$20.00 limit so that all toys will be of an equal value, you may of course donate more than one toy in the same price range.

Awards will be presented to 1st-3rd Place in each division: Civic/Church (Boy Scouts, churches, non-profits, etc.); Corporate (City/County departments, banks, Trane, etc.); Commercial (small businesses, dance academies, etc.) Judging will be conducted from 3:30-4:15pm. Winners will be acknowledged as they pass the judges stand on Public Square and will also be submitted to the newspaper.

Keep all routines moving, this includes all dance studios, bands, color guards and so forth. Please remember there is only one Santa and Mrs. Claus allowed in the parade and they are already lined up!
