1. Play Begins: August 14, 2011
2. Sanctioning Group: NSA
3. Softballs: 44 COR; 400 Compression---**Team purchases balls**
4. Tournament: Yes – Single elimination
5. Matching shirts: **No--** must have 6" commercial number (NO ½ numbers, decimals or 3-4 digit numbers allowed—2 DIGIT NUMBERS ONLY), no tape, markers or duplicate numbers allowed (#7 and #07 ARE THE SAME NUMBER)
6. Open/closed roster: Roster will close 2 weeks before end of season. Military may be added to roster at any time with proof of ID (still must have a City issued ID card).
7. Starting hour: 5:00pm/6:15pm/7:30pm
8. Rules Specific To League:
  - A. Stealing is allowed **AFTER BALL CROSSES HOME PLATE**
  - B. Limit of **7** home runs
  - C. If a home run is hit, all players **MUST TOUCH FIRST BASE**

Monday Co-Ed KICKBALL League  
Adopted July 9, 2011

1. Play Begins: August 15, 2011
2. Sanctioning Group: Recreation League
3. Kickballs: 10” WAKA approved ball; ---**Team purchases balls**
4. Tournament: Yes – Single elimination
5. Matching shirts: No—Must have 6” commercial number (NO ½ numbers decimals or 4 digit numbers allowed), NO tape, markers or duplicate numbers allowed. (#7 and #07 ARE THE SAME NUMBER)
6. Open/closed roster: No player may be added to the roster after the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) game. Military may be added to roster at any time with proof of ID (still must have a City issued ID card).
7. Starting hour: 6:30pm/7:30pm/8:30pm
8. Rules Specific To League:
  1. 4 Females/4 males required if fielding 8 players minimum-  
Must register 11 on rosters with max of 20
  2. Matching Uniforms are not required
  3. Teams must furnish their own 10 in. WAKA approved ball with  
1.5 lbs. of pressure
  4. Coaches are responsible for their player’s actions

2. Sanctioning Group: NSA
3. Softballs: 12' for men & women, 44 COR/400 compression—**Team purchases balls**
4. Tournament: Yes - Single elimination
5. Matching shirts: No—must have 6" commercial number (NO ½ numbers, decimals or 3-4 digit numbers allowed - 2 DIGIT NUMBERS ONLY), no tape, markers or duplicate numbers allowed(#7 and #07 ARE THE SAME NUMBER)
6. Open/closed roster: Closed 2 weeks before tournament. Military may be added at any time with proof of ID (still must have a City issued ID card).
7. Starting hour: 6:30pm/7:45pm/9:00pm
8. Rules Specific To League:
  - A. A Division - Limit 5 home runs. B Division – Limit 2 homeruns and progressive. Home runs must be run.
  - B. Players can play any position**

5. Matching shirts: **Yes**—must be identical(color, name, number, design) must have 6" commercial number (NO ½ numbers, decimals or 3-4 digit numbers allowed - 2 DIGIT NUMBERS ONLY), no tape, markers or duplicate numbers allowed(#7 and #07 ARE THE SAME NUMBER)
6. Open/closed roster: Closed 2 weeks before end of season. Closed for tournament. Military may be added at any time with proof of ID (still must have a City issued ID card).
7. Starting hour: 6:30pm/7:45pm/9:00pm
8. Rules Specific To League:
  - A. No stealing
  - B. Base paths – NSA rules 70' bases; 53' Pitching distance

July 9, 2011

1. Play Begins: August 19, 2011 (or when Spring League finishes)
2. Sanctioning Group: NSA
3. Softballs: 44 COR; 400 Compression---**Team purchases balls**
4. Tournament: No
5. Matching shirts: **Yes--** must have 6" commercial number (NO ½ numbers, decimals or 3-4 digit numbers allowed - 2 DIGIT NUMBERS ONLY), no tape, markers or duplicate numbers allowed(#7 and #07 ARE THE SAME NUMBER)
6. Open/closed roster: Close 2 weeks before season ends. Military may be added at any time with proof of ID (still must have a City issued ID card).
7. Starting hour: 6:30pm/7:45pm/9:00pm
8. Rules Specific To League:
  - A. No stealing
  - B. ~~5 Homerun limit~~—**SEE 'J'**
  - C. If a female batter follows a male batter who receives a walk, intentional or not, the female batter has the right to receive a walk without entering the batter's box. Once the female enters the batter's box she must bat. **On a walk all batters stop at 1<sup>st</sup> base.**
  - D. There must be a minimum of 2 women players on the field at all times during the game. If there is a woman injured leaving only 1 female on the field, then the game is a forfeit. If the team is using an EP female, then the EP goes to the field and an out is taken in the batting order for the injured player. A team can bat 12 players, but the extra players must be 1 male and 1 female. **(AMENDED June 21, 2005) If a team has 11 players present at the beginning of the game YOU MAY BAT 11 PLAYERS.**
  - E. If a player has a hard time running, a courtesy runner may be used. The courtesy runner must be the player who made the previous out; male for male and female for female.
  - F. If a home run is hit, all players must run all bases
  - G. Every player must attend a church function a minimum of 2 times a month. There will be a prayer before and after games.
  - H. When a female is at bat, outfielders may not cross the 50 ft. line until the ball is hit.
  - I. Pastor must approve and sign roster.
  - J. **Suggestion to NOT split the league(5 HR)—and if so, A has 3 HR/B has 5 HR**
