### CITY'S LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

Councillady Streetman made a motion to include widening 41-A Bypass from Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway to Riverside Drive to four lanes plus a center turn lane. The motion was seconded by Councilman Erb. Councillady Streetman said the additional lanes would improve future traffic flow for travelers visiting the downtown event center. A voice vote was taken; the motion passed without objection.

### MINUTES

#### CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the City of Clarksville Legislative Liaison Committee was called to order by Chairman Jeff Burkhart on August 4, 2020, at 2:00 p.m. in the City Hall Conference Room, 1 Public Square, Clarksville, Tennessee:

#### ATTENDANCE

PRESENT: Jeff Burkhart, Ron Erb

ABSENT: Stacey Streetman

Mayor Joe Pitts was also present.

#### ADOPTION OF MINUTES:

Councilman Erb made a motion to adopt the minutes of meetings held August 29, 2019 and July 21, 2020 as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilman Burkhart. A voice vote was taken; the motion passed without objection.

#### CITY'S LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

Mayor Pitts noted the following state road projects that the City should encourage funding and/or construction:

- SR48/Trenton Road (from SR374/101st Parkway to I-24: Encourage TDOT to complete PE-NEPA phase in a timely manner

Mayor Pitts said TDOT was currently reviewing this project for possible funding in 2025.

- I-24 widening (from Kentucky State Line to SR76/Exit 11): Encourage TDOT to obligate funding in the FY20-23 TIP

Mayor Pitts said this project is not yet funded; Councilman Burkhart said the request should include improving 41-A to four lanes between Clarksville and Pleasant View.

- SR374 Extension (Dotsonville Road to SR149): Encourage TDOT to obligate funding in the FY20-23 TIP

Councilman Erb said this extension would alleviate traffic on Boot Hill.

- SR374/Madison Street: Encourage TDOT to issue construction bid letting

During a discussion regarding road construction costs, Councilman Burkhart said funding is based on gas tax. Mayor Pitts felt the State should index gas taxes to keep up with costs of construction.

The request to renew the driver license fee from \$4 to \$10 would also be listed.
