EDITH PETTUS PARK

Clarksville Parks and Recreation and the City of Clarksville Housing & Community Development collaborated to replace the existing playground and construct restroom facilities to compliment the splash pad that was added two summers ago.

HERITAGE PARK

SPLASH PAD / PLAYGROUND

The new playground and splash pad areas meet current Americans with Disabilities Act guidelines making them the first of their kind in Clarksville.

The features in both areas are low to the ground to be easily reached, and all areas will be wheelchair accessible with the play structures including ramps.

Funds for the play areas have been raised by all three Rotary Clubs in Clarksville (Sunrise, Noon, and Sunset), and the Clarksville-Montgomery County Community Health Foundation

This new program offered at the Kleeman Community Center is open to any participants with physical or mental disabilities interested in learning to play the game of wheelchair basketball.

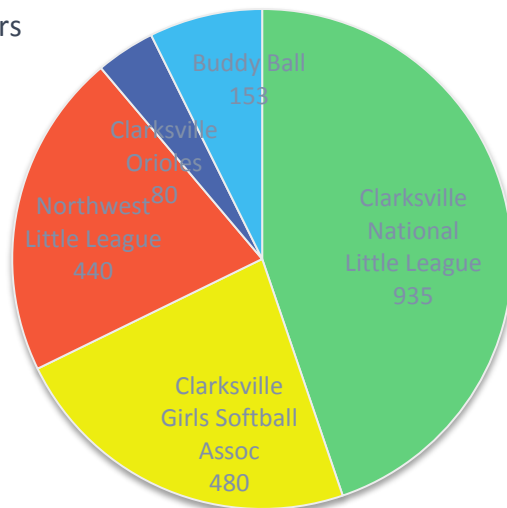


ADAPTIVE SOCCER

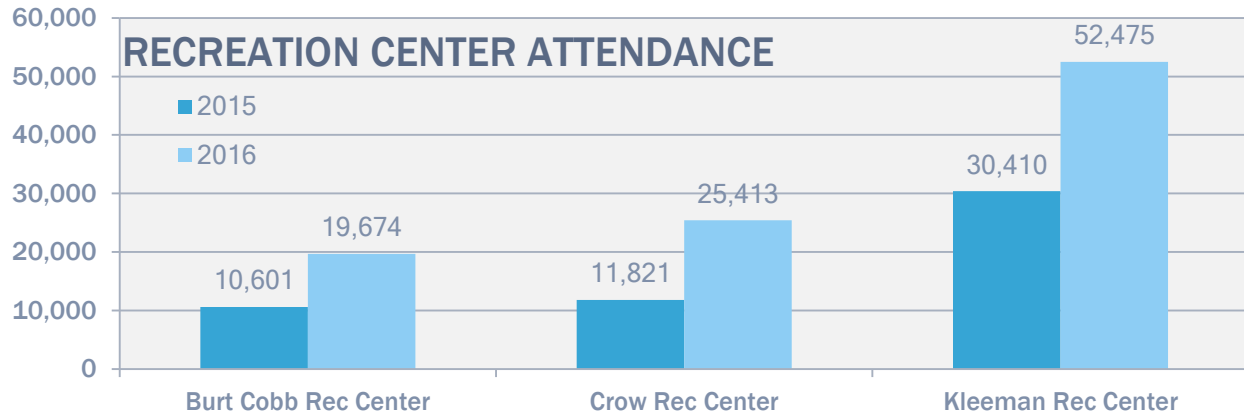

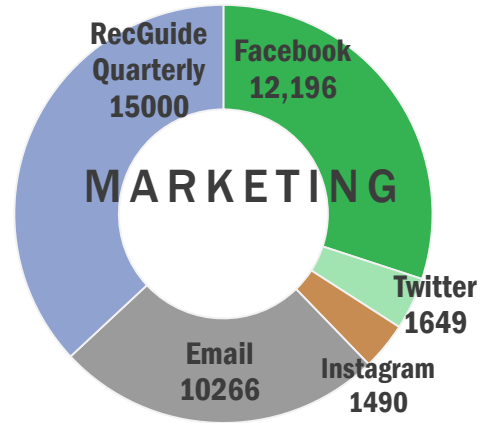
