The following has been taken from the Official Code of the City of Clarksville:

**Sec: 5-607 Limitation on number of yard sales.**

Holders of yard sales and/or garage sales shall be limited to holding two (2) sales per year within the City of Clarksville, each sale not to exceed three (3) consecutive days in length. The office of the Building and Codes Department is charged with the responsibility of keeping a record of when and where sales are held. Any person or persons holding more than two (2) sales annually shall be subject to application for a license from the Commissioner of Finance & Revenue under the Business Tax Act, and shall be subject to sales tax and may be required to keep an inventory of items on hand for the sale for inspection by the Commissioner of Finance & Revenue or his authorized agent.

**Sec: 5-608 Means of advertisement of yard sales: obstructing traffic.**

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons holding or engaging in a yard sale to cause congestion of traffic in the areas where the sale is being held. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons holding or intending to hold a yard sale to post advertisement of the sale on telephone poles, utility poles, or in any manner anywhere except for temporary signs (not to exceed six (6) square feet) within the yard or space where the sale is being held. Advertising also may be given to the local news media for publication or other means of informing the public.
